Modern IT Equipment for Artillery C³I Systems

ATM ComputerSysteme has won two contracts for series production of its latest computer generation CENTURION inclusive corresponding communication electronic, displays and custom-specific keyboards.

One of the both contracts was awarded by a foreign customer. First items were already shipped and will be integrated in Artillery weapon systems.

The other contract is part of a modernisation program of the German ADLER Artillery C³I system. Each Fire Direction Center will be equipped with two CENTURION workstations and 15 " Displays. The data exchange between the battery-, platoon- and battalion-level is managed by ATM`s Tactical router MCS 2000 KS using only VHF radios. The local data exchange is executed over an Ethernet network.

ATM`s Tactical router is an important component to manage different types of radios (VHF, HF), SatCOM, signal lines, ISDN etc. in modern Tactical networks. The Tactical router, based on an open architecture, can be adapted to any type of C³I.

The CENTURION offers outstanding characteristics for applications in armoured vehicles. Until now, the third German Artillery program has selected the CENTURION.
